

Science and Math Credential Checklist

IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN A SCIENCE CREDENTIAL:

- Take CSET General Science Subtest 1
- Take CSET General Science Subtest 2
- Take the CSET subtest that is directly related to your field of interest for your credential.

A student interested in earning a Biology Teaching Credential, for example, needs the following:

- CSET General Science Subtest 1
- CSET General Science Subtest 2
- CSET Biological Sciences Subtest

IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN A FOUNDATIONAL MATH CREDENTIAL:

- Take CSET Mathematics Subtest 1
- Take CSET Mathematics Subtest 2
- Note that the foundational credential only authorizes an instructor to teach from middle school mathematics up to Geometry.

IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN A FULL MATHEMATICS CREDENTIAL:

- Take CSET Mathematics Subtest 1
- Take CSET Mathematics Subtest 2
- Take CSET Mathematics Subtest 3 (Calculus)
- The full math credential is authorized to teach all grade levels of math, starting in middle school (6th grade onward).

IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN A MULTIPLE SUBJECT (ELEMENTARY) CREDENTIAL:

- Take CSET Multiple Subjects Subtest 1
- Take CSET Multiple Subjects Subtest 2
- Take CSET Multiple Subjects Subtest 3
- The multiple subjects credential authorizes teaching any subject in elementary schools (K-6).
