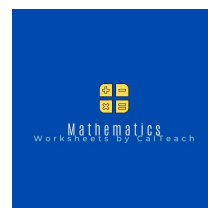

Standard to be Covered: Represent and solve problems involving addition and subtraction. Use addition and subtraction within 20.

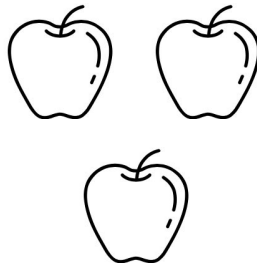
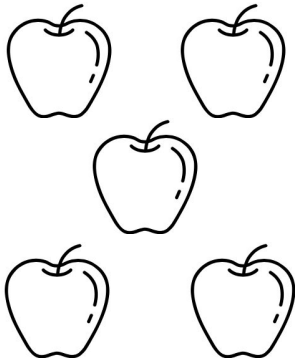

I went to the store and bought 5 apples. My mom has 3 apples. How many apples do we have together?



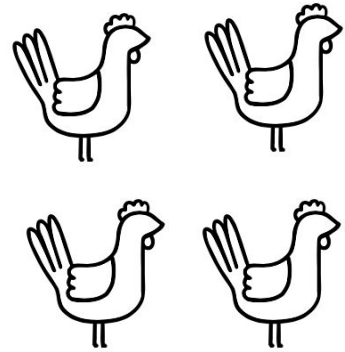
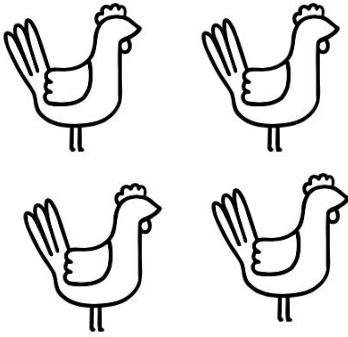
Exercise 2

Exercise 8

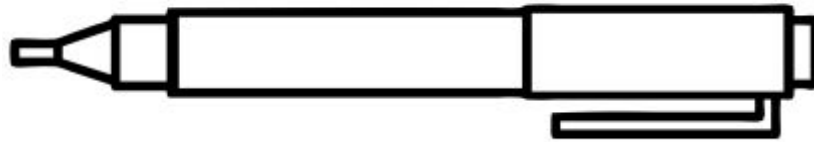
If I need 15 dollars to get into the game and I have 10 dollars, how many more do I need?

Jamie has 17 pens and April has 2 more than Jamie. How many pens does April have?



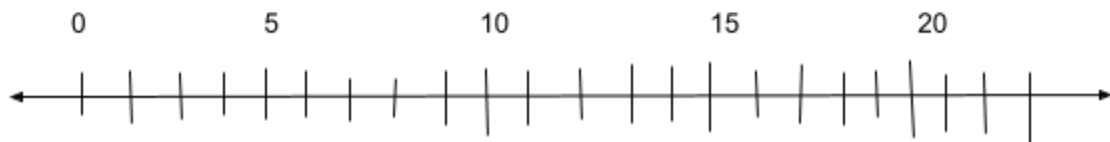
Exercise 10

My mom began with 10 cookies. I ate 2 and my brother had 3. How many cookies are left.

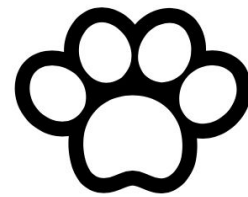
